A HANDY PLASTIC SCOOP



A simple handy scoop for use around the kitchen, garage and garden. It's ideal for rice, pulses, birdseed, kibble, compost, sand and nuts & bolts. You can also unscrew the lid and turn it into a convenient funnel

.....
YOU WILL NEED:

- An empty two pint milk carton
- Sturdy scissors
- Scalpel or craft knife

First of all, finish that milk off and make a nice cup of tea. Rinse out the empty carton, but you don't need to let it dry out. Using the a sharp knife or scalpel slice through the carton at the base, from here on we can use the scissors.

DID WE MENTION ABOUT THE DANGER OF SHARP KNIVES AND SO FORTH ?

Fig. 1 - First remove the base of the carton. Following the contours of the base should help keep the line straight.

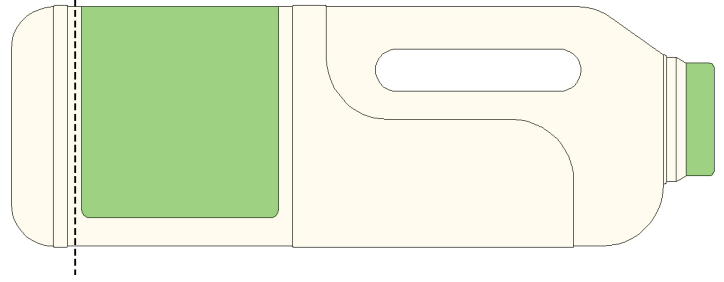


Fig. 2 - Carefully cut along into the carton, again following the contours on both sides. Cut up and round to remove the top part of the scoop.

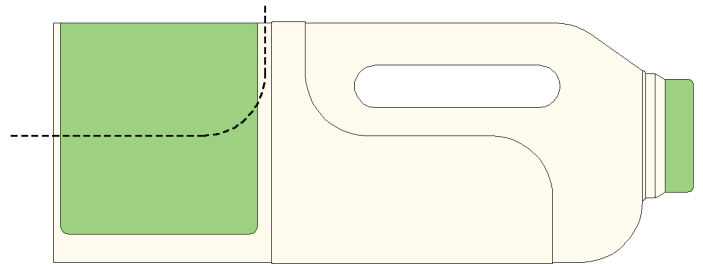


Fig. 3 - Tidy up the corners of the scoop with a simple curved edge.

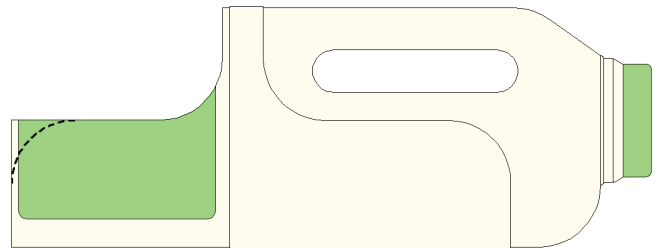
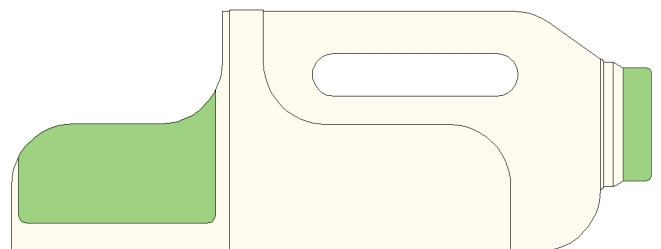


Fig. 4 - You may be able to remove the remains of the label. Any adhesive left on the pastic can be removed by dabbing it away with fresh sticky tape
